LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING CONCERNING DRESS CODE POLICY

All students attending WMST PCHS are REQUIRED to arrive at the WMST PCHS school house doors wearing the uniform each day that school is in session (with the exception of Head of School authorized dressed down days). Listed below is our uniform policy. The administration reserves the right to add or make changes to the Dress Code Policy at any time.

WMST PCHS uniforms consist of black or gray long/short sleeve polo shirts; white long/short sleeve oxford shirt; solid black, gray or navy blue fleece zip front jacket with no hood; solid black, gray or navy blue black long sleeve V neck pull over sweater; solid black, gray or navy blue black V neck sweater vest. All of these items must have the WMST PCHS logo.

No items can be worn as a replacement for the official uniform apparel. Young ladies can wear skirts, pants or jumpers in khaki color only. Young men can wear khaki colored long pants. Shorts will not be allowed for young ladies or young men.

- WMST PCHS students must have an official uniform.
- A student must have his/her uniform on when they arrive at school.
- Students will not be allowed to go to their locker to get uniforms or shoes.
- Only khaki colored skirts or pants will be allowed
- All uniforms must be an appropriate size and fit.
- Skirts must be worn no more than two inches above the knees

Students *may not* wear the following:

- Open toed shoes, flip flops, no shoes with heels that exceed more than two and one-half inches
- No sagging pants that fall below waist level and reveal under garments
- No Head Gear of any kind (scarves, bandanas, head bands, caps, hats etc.) will be worn at WMST PCHS. Students with religious affiliation must receive clearance to wear head gear from the Head of School
- Any articles of clothing or accessories that refer to sex, drugs or death
- Too tight clothing
- Unclean uniforms, students should be neat and clean daily
- No spandex, lycra or form fitting pants or clothing
- No outerwear (coats, jackets, etc.) should be worn during school hours. Only solid blue, black and gray cardigans are acceptable
- Parents will be notified if their child reports to school without proper uniform. These students are subject to being sent home or suspended.
