Purpose:

The 2011 Summer Session at WMST will focus on the following:

- ***Credit Recovery*** - WMST's summer school is aimed at helping students get back on track in terms of earned credits and achievement. Summer School is for credit recovery only. This means that students cannot take courses for advancement, but only for courses failed.
- ***STEP Program*** - Skill enhancement in the areas of reading, mathematics and science for students in the 9th grade entering WMST in the fall, 2011 (STEP – Student Transition Enrichment Program).
- ***Art, Literature and History in America*** - The program will be a combination of art, film, history and literature, with a writing component, for the period in America, South America, Europe, Africa and Asia... from the Revolutionary War through World War II. Each Friday we will go to a museum or memorial.
- ***DC CAS Preparation*** – Preparation in the reading, writing and math for rising sophomores.
- ***Johns Hopkins University Course*** “Engineering Innovation” for

pre-selected students offering 3 college credits.

- WMST students enrolled in the *“Passport to Work”* summer work program sponsored by the Office of Youth Programs.
